JLG Attachments - In the late 1960's John L. Grove, with his wife Cora embarked on a cross country trip in their RV. Newly retired, after spending numerous years working with his brother to develop their crane business into an industry leader, John had no idea that fatefull trip would permit JLG Industries, Inc to emerge. The world leader of mobile aerial work platforms and precision materials handling equipment was the end result of a road expedition.

While on their trip, John spent time conversing with past business acquaintances whom the Groves stopped to visit along the way. These conversations combined with a tragic occurrence-two workers being electrocuted on scaffolding when the Groves were traveling to the Hoover Dam- John discovered a vast marketplace for a product that could promptly and safely elevate people in the air to accomplish maintenance and other construction services.

Upon returning from their travels, John formed a partnership with two friends and purchased a metal fabrication business in McConnellsburg, Pennsylvania. In 1970, opening operations with a crew of twenty staff, they built and sold the first JLG aerial work platform. The company incorporates some of the basic design essentials of that original lift into existing versions.

Since then, JLG Forklifts have come a long way from when Mr. John L. Grove returned from his fatefull cross-country journey and since the first JLG aerial platform entered the marketplace. As of today, the company has expanded itself into quite a few international markets and continues to cultivate modern machinery to ensure that consumers are able to become safer and more resourceful within their workplace.
